### **Guidelines**

We are excited for the event and see it as being beneficial for all parties involved. However, very specific recruiting criteria must be abided by due to NCAA rules. Please note that these are only general guidelines. For more in-depth information, please consult the NCAA Web site [www.ncaa.org](http://www.ncaa.org) or your university compliance officer.

- Only rising high school seniors (i.e. those who will graduate in May or June of 2010), their parents and high school coaches may participate.
- College coaches may only contact a prospect after the completion of all of the prospect's races and only after the junior coach has released them.
- No more than two coaches may recruit off campus at the same time
- Recruiting brochures and other printed material may only be given to rising seniors.
